## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules of the International 110 Class Association and as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### **2 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND REGISTRATION**

**2.1** The regatta is open to skippers who complete the attached Entry Form and submit it, together with the required entry fee, to the Regatta Chairman on or prior to Saturday September 10, 2011.

**2.2** Skippers who have entered shall check in at the regatta registration table on Saturday September 10 before the start of the first race.

**2.3** A late entry and/or a late registration may be accepted, but races in which the entrant engages prior to receipt of the Entry Form and entry fee, or prior to completion of registration, will not be scored.

### **3 FEES**

The entry fee is \$50.

### **4 MEASUREMENTS AND INSPECTIONS**

**4.1** A safety equipment inspection may be conducted by the Race Committee at any time during the regatta.

### **5 RACE SCHEDULE**

**5.1** For Day 1, first race starts 1030. Day 2, first race starts 11:00.

**5.2** Saturday, Sept 10: Entries, Inspections and Registration 0900. Skippers' Meeting at 0930, first race starts 1030. Three races are planned for Sept 10.

**5.3** Sunday Sept 11: First race starts 1100. Two races are planned.

**5.4** The Race Committee shall have the discretion to increase or reduce the number of races on any day for the purpose of completing all planned races for the regatta.

### **6 SOCIAL EVENTS**

**6.1** Saturday Sept 10: BBQ outside the club downstairs starting 1830.

**6.2** Sunday Sept 11: Awards Ceremony at Inverness YC

### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**7.1** Restrictions posed by navigational and swim buoys are to be respected. Do not go through an imaginary straight line between two swim buoys.

**7.2** Starting line is unrestricted during the race.

### **8 VENUE**

Starting line will be at the end of the pier of the Inverness Yacht Club. The races will be held in Tomales Bay near the Inverness YC.

### **9 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be set using drop marks.

### **10 SCORING**

**10.1** The low point scoring system shall be used.

**10.2** A minimum of three completed races shall constitute a series.

**10.3** a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

### **11 BERTHING**

Competing yachts may be dry-sailed at Inverness Yacht Club and shall provide their own lifting slings.

### **12 HOUSING**

Competitors are encouraged to make housing arrangements early. Accommodations at homes of local sailors will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. In addition, local cottages, B&Bs and motels are available for rent. Motels and inns near the Club are Tomales Bay Resort, Inverness Valley Inn, 10 Inverness Way, Manka's, Dancing Coyote, and Motel Inverness.
